What: Youth Protection Training prepares the adult leader to work within the scouting program to help prevent child abuse. The leader will be instructed about child abuse concerns, BSA policies designed to protect Scouts from abuse, and resources available to prepare the youth to Recognize, Resist and Report abuse. Youth Protection Training is recommended for all leaders who work with youth in any scouting program. At least one member signing a Tour Permit must have Youth Protection Training. All adult training recognitions have Youth Protection Training as one of the requirements.
