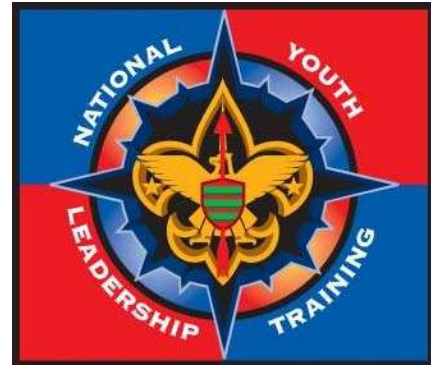

The fee for the course is \$240. A \$50 reservation deposit is required with the application. If selected, the balance is due by June 1, 2010. Failure to pay the balance by this date may cause a Scout to be dropped from the course. Many troops will pay part of the course fee. You should talk to your Scoutmaster. Scholarships may be available based on need.

The NYLT Troop Committee will review all applications and select a maximum of 36 Scouts for the course. After the selections have occurred, all applicants will receive written notice of their status. Those selected will receive detailed course information and materials. Those not selected may choose to remain on a waiting list or to be dropped from consideration and have their deposit returned.

There will be an orientation meeting on June 1, 2010 for all parents and participants.

All NYLT participants will be required to provide a completed Personal Health and Medical Record (Parts A, B, and C) along with a copy of insurance card (front and back) by June 1, 2010. A blank form will be provided if you are accepted to the course.

All NYLT participants are required to provide transportation for themselves and their equipment and report to the course in a complete official scout uniform with insignia in all of the proper places. An equipment list will be provided to those selected to attend. All Scouts selected to attend NYLT must attend the entire week of the course.

Registration deadline is April 30, 2010. Enrollment is limited to 36 participants, six patrols of six participants each. When the waiting list is established, those on the list will be first in line if another participant needs to withdraw before the course.

Make sure your name is printed neatly at the top of pages 2 through 6.
