

## *F*requently *A*sksed *Q*uestions

*Q* Do my son and I have to come with our Pack?

*A* No. You and your Son can come to camp by yourselves. When you get to camp you will be assigned a group for your stay in camp.

*Q* Do I have to buy a sleeping bag?

*A* No. Nights do get cool at camp, but if you bring sheets and a warm blanket you will be just fine.

*Q* What if I don't own a tent?

*A* No problem. You can use one of our tents. We supply tents with wooden floors and cots and are tall enough for you to stand up in.

*A* If you don't own a tent try to borrow one from a friend or neighbor.

*Q* Will I need hiking boots?

*A* While hiking boots are good, a comfortable pair of walking shoes will do just fine. We do NOT recommend sandals because of the open toes.

*Q* Will I need mosquito repellent?

*A* Yes, we're sorry to say, you will need mosquito repellent

*Q* Will my cell phone work at camp?
